PICKLEBALL GUIDELINES

- **Paddles are provided for lessons. Participants must bring their own paddle for drop-in play.**
- All six courts will be booked during lessons. See lesson schedule below.
- Participants must play on the designated court in accordance with their skill level, unless there is no one waiting to play.
- Games will be played up to 11 points, unless no one is waiting to play.
- Waiting players are asked to please sit at the chairs designated for each specific court. Players on the court will then rotate with players waiting on the chairs, whoever was there first. These chairs are not for holding personal belongings.
- Please be courteous of those waiting to play!
- See Pickleball Rule Book for questions about play.
- This is a drop-in program and play time is not guaranteed. Keep in mind if you come alone, there may be times there is no one to play with.
- **Participants MUST wear proper indoor runners. Please do not wear your outdoor shoes on the courts.**
- Participants MUST respect the property and equipment of the RM of East St. Paul. Please do not damage/steal/mistreat the paddles or nets.
- **Participants MUST act in a respectful and mature manner while on Municipal grounds.**
- Failure to comply with the above guidelines may result in suspension of participation or removal of the Pickleball program.
